

Free Will, Miracles and Destiny.

When we are first contacted by someone requesting a healing session we often consider completing a short discovery session with our Guides. This is different to reading the energy flow of a person. Chris and I simply call it a Q&A session. The intent is to establish if and how, we may be able to help the client to restore their health. Can we meet their expectations? What is it they need to get? Where do we need to go? What interferences are we likely to encounter? Will their Spirit accept the healing? These are all questions we have learnt to ask from hard experience. I have to say this is not automatic for every person but a definite for significant degenerative diseases. This is especially so when we are approached as a last hope.

Before we go any further I need to say that I don't expect you to believe anything that you read here. This article is an expression of what I have come to believe from asking a lot of questions. Questions that have arisen from the frustrations of working on some difficult cases. Cases that at times, have me asking "what's the point?" That and a number of other questions, the answers to which I have attempted to put into some logical sequence. I hope it makes some sense.

Will the Spirit of the client accept the healing? This may seem like an odd question as one would assume that anyone asking for help would be willing to accept it...but not so. Despite consciously agreeing to any healing some people will reject all efforts at the unconscious or Spirit level. This has to be one of the most frustrating aspects to helping some people. I know volumes have been written on this subject in some form or another. In her book, Dr. Myss reasons that we do not heal, because we use our illnesses or wounds as a way of gaining intimacy and even personal power over others. Perhaps Dr Myss is correct at some level, but I think it is much more complicated than that. Occasionally it is because as practitioners (and I include myself here) are looking in the wrong place. A little catch we have learnt to anticipate is who really needs the healing. Often more than one family member needs to have an imbalance restored in order for healing to be accepted by another. This is especially so when we get into the whole family relationships shamozzle where so much is happening on many different levels.

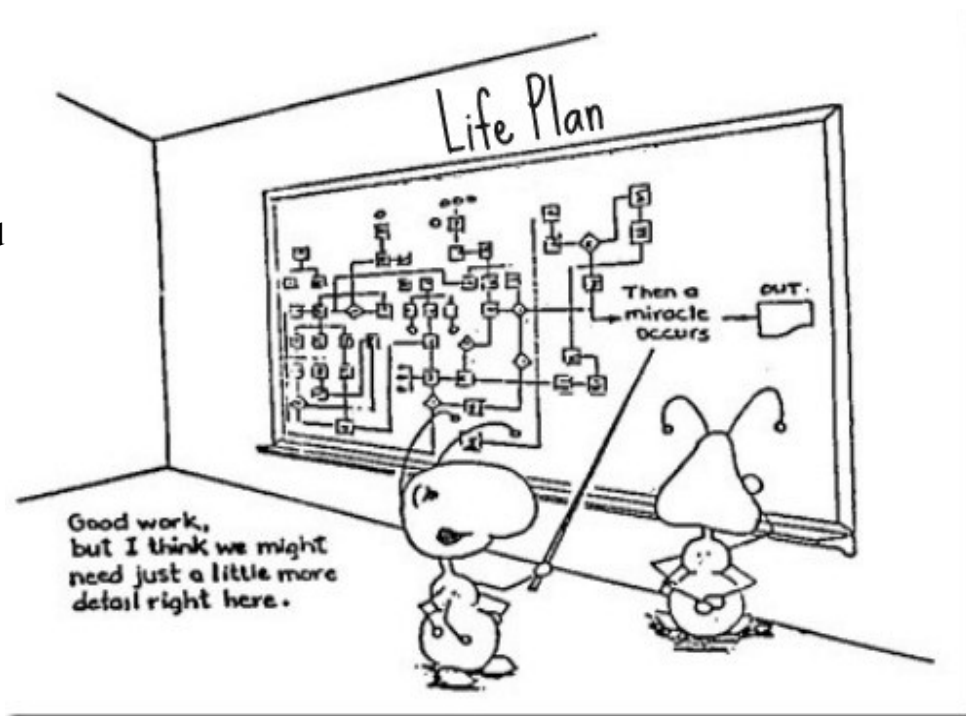
The fact is, our path as a human on planet Earth is quite a complicated existence. We exist as part of a three dimensional visible world and a multi-dimensional invisible world at the same time. This means we are subject to both physical laws and the laws governing a world we have little conscious knowledge of. In the past I tended to believe that all things are possible and if a person willingly asks for healing, the extent of that healing should not be limited or constrained. I have in the past argued that if the physical body consciously gives permission, and the Spirit of the client along with their Higher Self all agree, then complete and total healing should be granted. But it's not quite as simple as that. I know some people would say this is like expecting miracles and they'd be right. Why not? Aren't we told that all things are possible? It seems there is some fine print to "all things possible." It should read, "all things are possible within certain constraints."

I think most of us would agree with that we are Spiritual beings here on Earth having a human experience. The understanding of our life path or destiny however, is a more problematic concept. It has been commonly described that before we ever enter into any particular life cycle on this planet there is a process beforehand that will more or less guide you through your entire life. One needs to imagine a whole group of souls planning and preparing. Some of which will have experienced many incarnations together. It is a beautiful, meticulously and intricately planned event, each and every time a soul desires to re-incarnate. Some would also suggest that within those plans there are backup plans created, several in fact. I know people who are adamant that our exact time of death is predestined. Although this may be true for some, I'm not convinced that our whole life is totally mapped out for us in every detail, otherwise it would make a mockery of the whole "Free Will" idea. I feel it is more a case of milestones along a path.

Our choices within every moment, our every thought and words shared are creating new realities all the time. So the question is do we really have free will within the plan? The answer is yes to a certain degree...more constraints. We have free will in that we are throughout our life cycles, continually faced with choices. At times we will make certain choices intuitively and they will be in total alignment with our original contracts or agreements, or in other words the desired experiences we wish to live through in this life cycle. Because we are not aware of the original agreements or even the purpose of being here on earth, we often make choices that are not in alignment with our original Spiritual desires. So occasionally the Spirit of a client will reject all offers of healing in order to continue along their karmic path and reach a certain milestone. Is it possible they will accept help in another time? Yes it is possible, when the opportunity and timing is right. The flip side is that just because you have discovered a big hole in your karmic path, doesn't mean you can choose someone else to fix it.

Sometimes we will deviate from the original plan and this is where others come to help or Guide us. Often we are subjected to subtle or gentle guidance and other times the Universe will give us a big smack. Any and all choices we make while here on this Earth plane are always seen as experiences, which often times may well have proven to enhance the Spirit's original contract because of the experience. This is a good place to pop in a miracle. What is a miracle? The word comes from the Latin miraculum, 'object of wonder'. In modern discussions the term miracle has come to mean something like: a supernatural contradiction or violation of the laws of nature by divine intervention. Do miracles occur? Sure, but are they not determined by our belief in what is possible? What we now take for granted may well have been considered miraculous 100 years ago.

If healing has constraints how do we explain the work of someone like John of God? When I asked this question we were immediately answered with, "not everyone is healed." Let's look at John of God (Joao Teixeira De Fariafrom) from Central Brazil. You could argue that he is performing hundreds of miracles every day and it is to a large degree through the faith of those who seek his help. The question is how many people are actually cured or healed long term. If you have witnessed some of his techniques, it's a miracle anyone survives let alone be cured. Now don't get me wrong, I have nothing against this person. I appreciate he channels some significant energy and works with some heavy duty energy beings. I believe many people do receive what could be termed as miraculous healing and just as many if not more are simply in remission. If one of the milestones along your path is to experience such an event then you're in luck, but the next milestone could be another health set-back. It's whatever you agreed to. How many are not healed and how many return to their original path of chronic disease? We never get to hear about those statistics. If it was so simple we could all just line up and have all our health concerns dissolved. It's what you signed up for that counts.



I love this quote from “Conversations with God” by Neale Donald Walsch. “Judge not, then, the karmic path walked by another. Envy not success, nor pity failure, for you know not what is success or failure in the soul’s reckoning.”

One interesting constraint to miraculous healing is what is deemed acceptable and what is not. For example, to regrow a severed limb, although possible it is not acceptable in this dimension of time...we have yet to evolve to that level. On some other planet, in some other dimension, in some other life form it may be totally acceptable...but not here, not yet. I know some of you will say “but medical science has developed techniques that bring us very close to regenerating lost anatomy.” This is true and this is termed as “acceptable” because science is slowly bringing our awareness into a new dimension... slowly bringing us to acceptance of this possibility. This to me is part of the limiting beliefs in physical laws we must overcome. Our plan is set according to the rules of the game and we agreed to those rules. Just because the conscious mind, the Spirit and the higher self of a person all seek to be totally healed of a chronic disease, and believe it is possible, does not mean it will be granted. At some level you have agreed to the experience and it's in your plan. As previously described, sometimes we can be let off the hook, and again it is within certain constraints. I have witnessed dispensations where the progress of a chronic disease has been halted but not reversed. In this regards the Lords of Karma often play a role in healing sessions. For whatever reason, we can get trapped in a third dimension cycle of the same experience or lesson on many different levels. Simply going around and around with no obvious way out. Because continued suffering is not needed in order to learn, I believe the Lords of Karma can give us an opportunity to be released from a negative cycle in order to move on.

Occasionally we are knocked off our path by outside influences or interferences with significant ill health as a result. It is possible to naively choose an experience outside of our plan. When this occurs you can take your case to a higher authority and have the affects alleviated. Once again though, it's likely you agreed at some level to experience that outside interference. What commonly happens is that agreements are made without the full realisation of the consequences. Knowing this, higher beings will take steps in order for you to get back on your path. In the end that's what true healing is all about...getting back onto your path however rocky or smooth that may be. So do we get to reach every milestone in our plan? Some will and some will carry-over the lesson or imbalance to another time. But let's not be all doom and gloom. It's human nature to focus on the negatives in our life and ignore all the great things that happen to us. Often it just takes a little realisation or acceptance to make powerful and positive changes in our life. Once we take responsibility for our choices and accept our experiences the quicker we will move on to catch that next great opportunity. Trust me when I say, there are a myriad of beings on many different levels all waiting to help us to do just that...to help us get back on the path.

I want to close with this excerpt from “Conversations with God” Book 2, by Neale Donald Walsch.

All events, all experiences, have as their purpose the creating of *opportunity*. Events and experiences are Opportunities. Nothing more, nothing less. It would be a mistake to judge them as "works of the devil," "punishments from God," "rewards from Heaven," or anything in between. They are simply Events and Experiences...things that happen. It is what you *think* of them, *do* about them, *be* in response to them, that gives them meaning. Events and experiences are opportunities drawn to you...created by you individually or collectively, through consciousness. Consciousness creates experience. You are attempting to raise your consciousness. You have drawn these opportunities to you in order that you might use them as tools in the creation and experiencing of Who You Are. Who You Are is a being of higher consciousness than you are now exhibiting. Because it is My Will that you should know, and experience, Who You Are, I allow you to draw to yourself whatever event or experience you choose to create in order to do that. Other Players in the Universal Game join you from time to time...either as Brief Encounters, Peripheral Participants, Temporary Team-mates, Long-Term Inter-actors, Relatives and Family, Dearly Loved Ones, or Life

Path Partners. These souls are drawn to you by you. You are drawn to them by them. It is a mutually creative experience, expressing the choices and desires of both.

No one comes to you by accident.

There is no such thing as coincidence.

Nothing occurs at random.

Life is not a product of chance.

Events, like people, are drawn to you, by you, for your own purposes. Larger planetary experiences and developments are the result of group consciousness. They are drawn to your group as a whole as a result of the choices and desires of the group as a whole.
